



Clay Rain Stick Workshop at the ClayFox Clay School Guest Instructor Liz Bishop Saturday, April 18 at 2:00 PM

The ClayFox Clay School is pleased to offer a class on making rain sticks. Each participant will create a clay rain stick about 12" tall that has the sound of soft flowing water every time it moves! It's total clay magic how this works!

Session 1 ~ Saturday April 18 ~ 2:00 PM to 4:30 PM

This session will center on using the slab roller to make flat pieces of clay that will be shaped into the rain stick. We'll use texture and design to create the masterpieces. These pieces will then dry and be fired in the electric kiln and ready for glazing in a future session. No clay experience necessary, just a desire to have some muddy fun!

Session 2 ~ to be arranged for the final glazing of the pieces

In this session we will apply glaze to the rain sticks and get them ready to fire in the gas stone-ware kiln. Pieces will fire within a week of this class and be ready for pick up.

Class starts at 2:00 PM with a yummy desert. Bring your sweet tooth, your own creative hands and just expect to have a good time!

No clay experience necessary. This is going to be a FUN class.....**but then everything at the ClayFox Clay School is based on fun!** Limited to 8 people so sign up quickly! It's going to fill up.

The last class was a kick!
